Educational Assessment Services

Purpose: To provide accurate diagnosis for optimal educational structuring and planning in order for the student to learn at their optimal level.

Issues addressed:

- Developmental Delay
- Traumatic Brain Injury
- Aspergers' Syndrome and Autism
- School Readiness
- Reading Problems such as dyslexia
- Math Problems such Dyscalculia
- Writing problems such as Dysgraphia
- Attention Deficit, ADHD
- Learning problems

Solution:

Quantitative evaluation through neuropsychological testing provides a description of school potential versus academic achievement, attention/concentration, memory and learning style, as well as emotional adjustment. This area is considered to be vital to the development of appropriate educational planning and serves as a baseline to compare and evaluate future assessments across time.

Forensic Assessment Services

Purpose: To apply the scientific principles and practices of neuropsychology to questions and issues relating to law and the legal system.

Areas of Concern:

 - Examine the validity, admissibility, and quality of prior evaluations.

Solution:

Quantitative evaluation through neuropsychological testing to assess concerns of memory, effort and motivation, attention, language, visual-spatial, memory and reasoning skills. A formal unbiased report is provided along with an interpretive session, when available; or a thorough unbiased review of previous neuropsychological testing.

Purpose: To apply the scientific principles and practices of neuropsychology to questions and issues relating to memory disorders and the rehabilitation for areas of decline, if possible, in order to allow the patient to function at their optimum level of well-being
